Throughout this process there is an application monitoring the files and various other processes and notifications / reports are sent to customers and internal support staff to keep them apprised of the process flow. The entire process is automated.

Also responsible for developing an internal application for processing Scantron-based Health Risk Assessment forms and several other smaller applications.

Additionally responsible for developing web applications in Visual Studio 2005, SQL Server 2005 and West Wind Web Connection 5.03.
